Sheriff Evans:

At 9:10pm on Thursday, 02/04 we sent you a letter asking you to stand up for the community you were elected to represent and assign all possible resources to investigate the pedophile ring and financial crimes in Calvert County Public Schools. At about 2pm on Monday, 02/08 you announced on Facebook you are not running for another term, but we have received no response from you. In October of 2019 Superintendent Daniel D. Curry said we had been referred by the BoE to law enforcement, through CCPS' attorneys from PK Law, only for them to walk back that claim and suggest we sit down with you and the Superintendent. Did that strike you as odd? Does it bother you your name was used for purposes of intimidation in an attempt to violate our First Amendment rights? That was right after the first letter we sent to CCPS where we all but stated the Superintendent is a pedophile, and hinted his wife, Jacqueline Wisnauskas, who teaches 1st grade at Patuxent Appeal Elementary, is somehow party to his sexual abuse of children. Patuxent Appeal is the most dangerous and violent elementary school in the County. Then, a couple of months later, also under the auspices of CCPS, Daniel D. Curry had a local attorney send us a cease and desist letter, on which the State's Attorney's Office was copied. Although CCPS encumbered \$2500 for that attorney's fees, less than a thousand was spent. If our allegations weren't true, why wouldn't Daniel D. Curry, and maybe his wife, have sued us personally by now, instead of hiding behind CCPS, the BoE, *you* and the State's Attorney's office?

Our story pursuing this situation starts at Southern Middle School, the most dangerous and violent middle school in the County. We didn't know why then-SMS vice principal Travis Mister was accusing our daughter and 8-10 of her peers of bullying a young man who was disturbing and terrorizing them. We didn't know why Travis Mister appeared to be encouraging and rewarding that young man's misbehavior. I couldn't ignore then-Principal Mandy Blackmon's sneaky, even tone and snotty dismissals of my concerns, and could tell any time I inquired on my daughter's behalf it would probably make life worse for her, so was very measured and restrained. It was apparent to me it was impossible to work with those people and knew a complaint would need to be made to the CCPS Superintendent, Board and Executive Staff. That complaint resulted in retaliation and abuse ordered and orchestrated by Daniel D. Curry himself, forcing us to remove our daughter from CCPS, and shortly afterward our sons, because it was impossible to get to our daughter, so our sons became targets. Fortunately, we got out our sons before they were hurt and all three of our kids are doing well and safe in a caring


and supportive (and secular) private school. While we are thrilled with the education and support our kids are receiving and grateful we have the resources to ensure that, parents should not have to look to home or private school situations in order to guarantee their kids are not directly targeted for abuse by a slew of “educators.”

In your February 8th announcement you stated “until November 2022, know that I am unwavering in my commitment to serving as your Sheriff.” With nearly a year left in your last term, there is still plenty of time for you to investigate and address our allegations of financial crimes and a pedophile ring in CCPS. On February 16th, you endorsed Lieutenant Colonel McDowell for Sheriff, in anticipation of him announcing his candidacy at the end of the month. We will copy him on this letter, as well as all other candidates of whom we are aware. The sooner these problems in CCPS, which bleed in to every part of the community, are finally addressed, the better off the community you were elected to serve will be. It would also help any successor of yours hit the ground running. To quote Calvert County Commission President and BoE member when it was learned what happened to our daughter and what Travis Mister was doing, Kelly McConkey, in the Calvert Recorder, “he’s done an excellent job making sure police were in the schools.” “He’s done a good job keeping Calvert safe.”

We have made serious sacrifices and taken on significant risk in pursuing this situation. We have no designs on remaining in Calvert County, know at some point we will not be safe to remain and are growing increasingly worried about our safety, but we cannot know what we know and not do the right thing. We are telling the truth.
