Daniel D. Curry:

We received "Ms. Maxey's" 2/22 estimates for our 2/3 and 2/8 PIA requests. The breakdowns are as follows, and then we'll address some other things.

- 02/03 – 21 POs, 31 invoices and 34 checks/vouchers/payments for MABE Group Insurance, Legal Services and Workers' Comp Self Insurance Fund. The estimate of 17.75 hours at \$45.50/hr., for a total cost of \$716.62 with a deposit of \$350 is ludicrous. Before 2 hours are waived that means the total cost for these records is \$807.12. In all likelihood these records will total 86 pages. That means each page would cost ~\$9.39 and almost 5 pages can be produced per hour.
  - o We enumerated some of our reservations about MABE in a 10/14 letter, including violating a Workers' Comp order and how they procure candidates like you and Jack Smith during "national" superintendent searches. We wonder how much and what else MABE has done.
  
- 02/08 – 13 POs, 27 invoices and 22 payments/checks/vouchers for Luckoba, LLC; 1 PO, 1 invoice and 1 check/voucher/payment for Lives in the Balance; 6 invoices and 2 checks/vouchers/payments for Louise Floren; and, 2 POs, 9 invoices and 9 checks/payments/vouchers for M & E Sales. The estimate of 17 hours at \$45.50/hr., for a total cost of \$682.50 with a deposit of \$350 is ludicrous. Before 2 hours are waived that means the total cost for these records is \$773.50. In all likelihood these records will total 93 pages. That means each page would cost ~\$8.32 and around 5.5 pages can be produced per hour.
  - o Luckoba LLC provides IT services for CCPS. There is no reason to believe they provide anything other than a quality service; however, we are curious about CCPS technology setups.
  - o On 1/22/20 we mentioned a sole-source (no-bid) contract awarded by the BoE on 1/09/20 to Dr. Ross Greene's nonprofit organization Lives in the Balance, which utilizes its very own "Punitive Index," with the goal of discouraging law enforcement referrals, out-of-school suspensions, etc.. \$36,000 was budgeted, at \$600/hr., but the records we do possess show only \$18,000 was spent. Why? At the same 1/09/20 Board meeting where that contract was unanimously approved,

a contract for \$58,700 was awarded to Curriculum Management Systems of Johnston, IA, for a “curriculum audit of the Calvert County Public Schools’ elementary educational program;” yet, it doesn’t appear any money was spent on that. I pointed out Dr. Fenwick English of CMS “is in his early 80s, became a vice principal after three years of teaching, after one more year became a principal and not long afterward left the schools for higher administration, academia and consulting.” Did the Board rescind approval of that no-bid? Why not reject both bids, as we requested? The Board shouldn’t trust any sole-source recommendations of yours. Even if the services provided are legitimate, your motives are not.

- Over a weeklong period in March of 2017 CCPS paid \$35,501.45 for 6 different invoices to a Louise Floren, \$30,369 of which may be a “refund.” These may be legitimate expenditures, but there are no expenditure descriptions, which is unusual.
- M & E Sales installed a chiller at Patuxent High School and there is no reason to believe they provide anything other than a quality service; however, payments for around \$320,000 of the \$1 million + project appear to have been paid from a hidden fund. Could it be *Fund 7*? Maybe some other fund?

On 12/08 we sent a letter asking what you think any boys Travis Mister may have harmed at Southern Middle School must feel if they see him around Calvert High/the CTA. Is Travis Mister still there? His name hasn’t been mentioned in personnel reports as having taken a leave of absence, resigning, etc.. Of course, that wouldn’t be any different than any of the other times he’s been moved around the system and never mentioned in those same reports. What is his employment status with CCPS? Why didn’t he lose his job when the Board learned he was terrorizing students and colleagues, blowing up my phone in the mornings for about 3 weeks in May of 2018, setting up students, and most important and worst of all, targeting boys for sexual abuse? Why wasn’t he mentioned in personnel reports when he was *promoted* to vice principal at Southern Middle, for the 2014-2015 school year, right after you arrived in CCPS? Have you or anyone else knowingly and deliberately made sure Southern Middle hosted any other pedophile/s at any other point/s? We think so. Why was Travis Mister quietly transferred from Southern Middle to Plum Point Middle, which is the other Behavioral Development Program middle school in the County? Why, after only one year, was he then transferred to the CTA at Calvert High? Why weren’t the evil, malignant mean girl teachers and others who plotted and schemed to try to drive my daughter to a breakdown or suicide exposed and terminated? Why did vile, evil former principal Mandy Blackmon - who has been on a nearly three-year-long character assassination trip against our family – receive a paycheck for well over a year after the Board learned what she really is? Just because there is a dearth of teaching talent and positions go unfilled doesn’t mean keeping around “educators” and “administrators” like them is a good idea. We are eager to expose them for what they have done, and they should have been terminated when it was learned what they did. Conversely, we will be eager to publicly proclaim and thank every Southern Middle educator who refused to participate and/or helped to expose what happened to Sarah. You don’t mind promptly terminating caring, decent educators when they refuse to or cannot submit to more abuse, and you enjoy stringing them along, only to pull out the rug after nearly destroying them.

And you continue to reveal yourself on your @CalvertSuper Twitter page. You *finally* called out your wife in full, after for so long making only veiled references to her! It must have been quite the scandal which had you, her and your first wife all leaving Delaware at the same time. When you left Lake Forest, DE you said you would be retiring, but instead interviewed for new roles and ended up here. What did the Lake Forest, DE district know, and why were they so eager to make you go away? How about other districts you ran? The Delaware Academy of School Leadership at the University of Delaware helped procure Steve Lucas to be Lake Forest's new superintendent. The selection process had a very MABE-esque vibe. We don't know if Jacqueline Wisnauskas actively molests children, but at the very least you and she exploit her role to procure children for *you* to molest, and she knows EXACTLY what is going on. Do you think her recent doctorate should comfort people that she's not what she is? You have a doctorate, too. If someone accused either of us of being a pedophile, we would take immediate legal action. Other than that pathetic cease and desist letter you had CCPS pay for over a year ago, which only made you look like an ass, when are you and your mistress-wife going to sue us? We can prove more than you think and welcome the prospect. Let's go. On 02/04 we asked you what Rep. Steny Hoyer "might think to know the educational nonprofit established in his wife's memory [Judy Centers, like at PAC] is being in any way exploited to facilitate yours and others' sick perversions," so you retweeted his 2/23 post in honor of Public Schools Week, where he mentioned his late wife was a "tirelessly" "dedicated educator." How dare you!? You also tweeted a couple of photos of a *female* baby, whose full name you used, in a Calvert Tots onesie, to contradict the apt observation that you posted for so long pictures of only *male* babies in those same onesies, calling them things like "handsome young *men*." (emphasis ours) The CCPS logo placement on the back of the onesie is interesting. Why does CCPS fund this program, when by law CCPS is responsible for 3-21-year olds? Do you get permission from these infants' parents to put out these pictures, sometimes with names and other identifying information? We've been dog walking you for almost 3 years and will continue.


You were on your best, least creepy and perverted behavior for the recent State of the Schools address. If a person didn't know better, they might think you actually care about this community, kids, staff and the system you have helped run in to the ground. You don't. Of the 5 Strategic Plan areas you addressed – Equity, Student Outcomes, Gifted and Talented Education, the Workforce and Community Engagement – you didn't focus too long on Community Engagement. A number of confirmed and potential partnerships enumerated in the presentation slide sound *very* promising and beneficial for all involved, but we do hope your statement that CCPS' Community Engagement effort "involves more volunteers and community connections" means all aspects will be well-monitored and run. As CCPS has "revised the volunteer process to align to the new Raptor System" and "updated [the] volunteer application and training process," we hope all volunteers will be fully and responsibly vetted. Is CCPS really "one of the best districts in the state?" If so, and although in no way reflective of the majority of caring, capable educators in CCPS, this whole state needs a lot of help, but who doesn't know that?

After we emailed Sheriff Mike Evans on Thursday, February 4<sup>th</sup>, asking him to assign all possible resources to investigate what we have been alleging for almost three years, he announced he is not running for a 6<sup>th</sup> term. We will be sending him another letter, and copy all

current prospective candidates for Sheriff of whom we are aware, again asking for his and the Sheriff's Office's assistance. After a break, I will resume making PIA requests this week.
